This offering also includes a pool complex, a separate cottage, a small utility storage building, a guest house/lodge, a 22-stall horse barn, a stable, and a machine/equipment shop.



The original portion of the Foxwood residence was a rural farmhouse built in the 1840's. In 1987/88 Robert and Faye Kilpatrick completely rebuilt the original, added the wings, moved the existing garage, and created a new personalized residence. The house site is well-landscaped, with about 1.6 acres framed by paddock fencing. Improvements include an expansive lawn, cobblestone lined gravel drive and parking area, brick walks, and a 630 sqft brick terrace. On the property is an approximately 2-acre pond, 3 board fencing, multiple paddocks and pastures, and equestrian and farm improvements.



Exterior Features

- Brick foundation
- Painted redwood clapboard siding
- Slate roof
- Covered front porch
- Wood double-hung insulated windows
- Large brick terrace; small dining terrace outside the kitchen butler's pantry
- Mature landscaping with boxwoods, magnolia, holly, crepe myrtles and evergreens
- Detached utility building 10.7' x 10'7 has a brick foundation, pyramidal slate roof, shiplap siding, cornice brackets, a plywood floor and walls. It is divided into a garden tool room and a small electrical panel closet.

Interior Features

- Plaster and drywall finishes
- Pegged wide plank hardwood flooring
- Fireplaces in eight rooms
- Two-member crown moulding and chair rail throughout most of the first floor
- Attached two-car garage with painted sheetrocked walls and ceiling
- Unfinished basement with mechanicals
- Small utilitarian cellar with a concrete floor houses the furnace and water purification system.

Mechanicals

- 5-zone oil hot water heating system; central air conditioning
- 400-amp circuit breaker system with 200 amp for the garage apartment
- Security system
- Private well and septic systems

Pool Complex

- Inground pool measures 24' x 48'
- Salt gernerator
- Surrounded by a brick terrace and is enclosed by a brick retaining wall and stately board fencing
- Sitting area under a covered trellis
- Two pavilions 10'7 x 10'7 provide space for changing and housing pool equipment; both have painted clapboard siding and a slate roof; the changing pavilion has a sink, vanity, closet, shower and toilet; the equipment pavilion has an equipment room and a bar with a sink, cabinets and a serving counter that opens to the patio area

Garage Apartment

- Separate apartment over the garage is accessible from the interior of the garage and has an outside entrance
- Includes a 19' x 15' sitting room with a kitchenette, a 14' x 10' bedroom, and a full bath
- Heat pump and security system









<u>Main Residence First Floor</u>

Foyer/Stair Hall 15'9 x 12'5 Hardwood floor; crown moulding and chair rail; staircase; open to the back gallery; doors to the library/living room, basement, and den/office; recessed panel front door with side lights







Back Gallery/Cross Hall – connects the "front rooms" to the "back rooms" and both wings (kitchen and sun room) Hardwood floor; decorative columns with raised bases; full light doors to the back walkway to the pool complex; two large windows; also opens to a back hallway with a double coat closet and powder room with a pedestal sink and wood floor



Library/Parlor 17' x 15' (right of the foyer) Hardwood floor; crown moulding and chair rail; wood burning fireplace with slate hearth and surround; full wall of built-in bookcases and storage cabinets; opens to the foyer and to the gallery





Den/Office 16' x 15' (left of the foyer) Hardwood floor; window; fireplace with an antique mantle; to the foyer and to the gallery; could be a first floor bedroom (with easy access to the powder room next door)



Dining Room 20' x 15' Hardwood floor; Zuber French wallpaper mural (similar to wallpaper in the White House) with hand-blocked scenes; two windows; wood burning fireplace with marble hearth and surround; built-in display cabinets with glass shelving, arched tops and storage below; opens to the kitchen and to the gallery



Kitchen 19' x 12'

Hardwood floor; octagonal window over double sink; triple bay window at the breakfast area; open shelf to butler's pantry; built-in pantry with pull out drawers; Corian countertops with decorative tile accents; tile backsplash; appliances include disposal, dishwasher, electric cooktop with griddle and fan, double built-in Thermador ovens, SubZero side-by-side refrigerator/freezer; open to the butler's pantry/utility room

Butler's Pantry/Utility Room 15'8 x 7'

Brick floor; door to the garage; full light door to the back brick walkway and dining terrace; laundry closet; folding counter with sink and cabinets; octagonal window










Living/Family Room 26' x 15' (back right – includes gallery area) Sunken with ceiling beams; hardwood floor; six windows; arched wood burning fireplace with slate hearth and surround; recessed lighting



Serving Bar 13'3 x 7' Along the Gallery; hardwood floor; built in marble bar with copper sink and storage; octagonal window; full light doors to the brick terrace and full light doors to the sun room; recessed panel wall panels



Sun Room 20' x 20' approximate and irregular

Octagonal shaped; brick floor laid in herringbone pattern; full light cupola with decorative chandelier; shingle walls; coffered beamed ceiling with v-groove board; 8 double full-light windows/doors; opens to the serving bar, brick terrace, back yard and front yard



<u>Second Floor</u>

Sitting Room for the Guest Suite 15'8 x 13'9 (left front) Hardwood floor; window; wood burning fireplace flanked by built-in bookcases and storage; door to the hall and on to the bathroom and to the guest bedroom





Full Bath

Wood floor; marble vanity with storage below; tub/shower with tile surround; window; double closet

Guest Bedroom 16'9 x 15'3 (left back) Hardwood floor; two windows; wood burning fireplace with brick hearth and marble surround; built-in closets and cabinets





Master Bathroom Tile floor; tile shower with built-in bench and frameless glass door; Master Suite Sitting Room 15'6 x 15'6 (right front) Hardwood floor; window; wood burning fireplace with brick hearth and marble surround; door to full bath; hall to cedar closet and master bedroom







raised cultured marble vanity and a second vanity; window; jetted tub with cultured marble and tile surround and a built-in display shelf

Hallway

Hardwood floor; full light door to observation deck; 11' x 7'10 lockable cedar closet; door to master bedroom



Master Bedroom 18'7 x 15'4 Hardwood floor; four windows; wood burning fireplace with brick hearth and surround, flanked by arched-top closets



<u>The Cottage</u>





Exterior Features

- One-and-a-half story cottage built in the 1970's with 774 square feet of living space
- Brick foundation with stained plywood and batten siding
- Shingle roof
- Covered front porch

Interior Features

- Random width pine floors
- The interior has a living room with a vaulted ceiling, wood wainscoting, a fireplace and a kitchenette with an apartment-sized range with oven, a sink and cabinetry.
- It also has a bedroom and bath with a tub/shower and laundry hookups on the first floor.
- Upstairs is a sleeping loft and a half bath.

Mechanicals

- Electric baseboard and a heat pump (HVAC)
- Instant hot water heater
- 200-amp circuit breaker system

Building Features of the Residence

- Brick foundation with a frame structure
- Cypress and cedar siding
- Wood double-hung windows
- Composition shingle roof

Interior Features

- Pine floors
- Drywall painted or decorated
- First floor living room with dining area, dining or family room, utility room, bedroom and full bathroom
- Off the kitchen is an enclosed mud room with laundry
- Second floor has two bedrooms, a full bath and an office/sitting room
- Kitchen has ceramic tile floors, Corian counters, wood cabinets, a dishwasher, and a range with oven
- Living room has a lofted beamed ceiling and stone fireplace
- Dining room has pine board wainscoting, an a bay window
- The first floor bath has a tile floor, pedestal sink, and a ceramic tile shower.
- The second floor bath has a ceramic tile floor, pedestal sink and a tub with a shower.

Mechanicals

- Two-zone heat pump HVAC
- 200-amp circuit breaker panel

Located just to the southwest of the main house, the guest house has an elevated site with a good views to the west. It is accessed by a gravel driveway off the main access road. The dwelling was originally constructed in 1976-77 with an addition in 1986-88, and it contains approximately 2,015 square feet.

There is a detached 20' x 12' office with an attached 10' shed. It is a frame structure. The office has a pine floor, lofted ceiling and a heating/AC unit. There is also an old garage with vinyl and plywood siding, a metal roof, and pole structure.









The Horse Barn





This facility was constructed in the 1960's-70's and contains 5,628 square feet, measuring 39.7' x 141.5'. It was used by the previous owner for training and boarding horses.

Building Features

- Cinderblock structure
- Composition shingle roof with copper gutters and downspouts
- Metal casement windows and plywood ceiling
- Sliding barn doors on each end
- Asphalt center aisle
- Located in the approximate center of the building is the tack room and an adjacent kitchenette and toilet
- Electric heat
- Across the aisle is the wash bay with concrete floor and a feed room that provides access to a floored loft that is divided into large storage spaces
- 22 stalls plus a wash stall; stalls each measure approximately 10' x 13.5'
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<u>Stable</u>

This is an old structure built of post and beam construction with board and batten siding and a metal roof. It is an open shelter across the front with six stalls. A wire cage encloses two of the end stalls. It has 1,591 square feet and measures 12' x 72.3" with a 9.5' shelter extending the entire length. It is currently used for miscellaneous storage.




Machinery/Shop Building


This structure was built around 1987-88 and measures 40' x 148' with 5,220 square feet. It is arranged with a shop, five equipment bays, and a storage room. It has a perimeter concrete foundation and a truss roof system with a clear span. Siding is treated board and batten, and the roof is composition shingle with copper gutters and downspouts. Ten skylights provide natural light and two ventilating cupolas provide circulation.


- The shop is approximately 34.5' x 40' and has a concrete floor, plywood walls and ceiling, wall insulation, 16' ceiling height, skylights, 200 amp circuit breaker panel, two ceiling fans and a wood stove; access is provided by two pass doors and a 14' overhead door with an automatic opener
- Adjacent to the shop is the toilet room measuring 9.5' x 10.3'
- At the opposite end is a 20' x 40' storage room with a concrete floor, plywood walls and ceiling, rat wire, and a manual overhead door
- The equipment bays have gravel floors, five manually operated overhead doors, and wooden double-hung windows
- Additional storage is provided above the toilet, shop and storage room


